Signs of a severe reaction include: repetitive profuse vomiting, frequent diarrhea, lethargy (appearing very sleepy), loss of consciousness, and becoming pale or blue/gray in appearance. In the event of severe reaction, call 911 and the emergency contact:
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This card is a great companion to your child's FPIES ER letter when your little one requires emergency care. It is also a great tool to keep on hand for school, daycare and travel instances. The top section is the back of the card and the bottom section is the front of the card. Fold in the center of the two sections to make a complete card with a front and a back and if desired, laminate to preserve the card. Fill out your child's information clearly and as completely as possible. At the bottom of the front of the card, check which lines apply to your child. This specific version of the FPIES information card is designed to offer you space for filling in additional pertinent information about your child that is not addressed in other areas of the card but may be important to caregivers or emergency responders.
